

The CCCSAA Student Leadership Scholarships are awarded to a currently enrolled community college students involved in campus leadership. Student applicants must be from a college with an advisor who is a current member of CCCSAA. Please consult your advisor for more information.

The CCCSAA Student Leadership Scholarships will be announced no later than **May 14, 2010**.

Amount:

Ten (10) scholarships at \$750 each will be awarded

1. Five (5) scholarships to five students in Region I-V
2. Five (5) scholarships to five students in Region VI-X

Deadlines:

To advisor for review: Friday, March 26, 2010

To CCCSAA President-Elect: Friday, April 2, 2010 for review: (received by faxed or post marked)

Eligibility:

1. Currently enrolled in a minimum of nine (9) units at a community college during **Fall 2009/Spring 2010**
2. Have a minimum of 2.5 cumulative G.P.A. in all college work.
3. Participation in campus leadership during some period from **May 2009 – March 2010**.
4. One or more advisors on your campus must be a current CCCSAA member.

Selection Process:

1. Applications need to be turned into each campus student government advisor by **Friday, March 26, 2010**
2. The advisor will verify eligibility of the student.
3. No more than two applicants from each campus may be forwarded to the CCCSAA President-Elect, Frankie Moore for consideration.

CCCSAA Selection Procedures:

1. No Advisor will read applications from his/her own region.
2. The Statewide Selection Committee is comprised of the President-Elect, three advisors from Regions 1-5 and the Northern Area Representative, and three advisors from Regions 6-10 and the Southern Area Representative. Representatives will abstain from reading finalists from their own campus.
